Registration can be done in one of three ways:

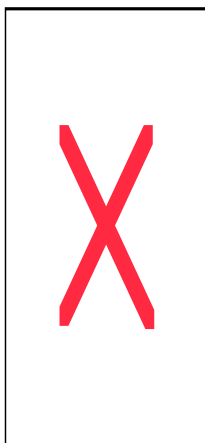
1. **Register by Mail.**

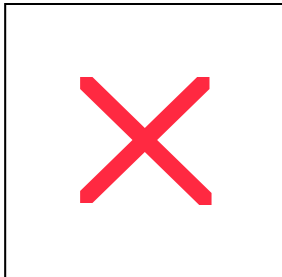

First Aid Refresher

First Aid is the immediate care that is given to a victim of an injury or illness before professional medical rescuers arrive. Your actions during the first minutes of an emergency can be critical. The first aid that you provide may mean the difference between life and death. This class is the refresher course and will allow participants to review first aid procedures and re-certify.
