608.1 SPECIAL EDUCATION AND TITLE I SERVICES FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish school district guidelines for the provision of special education and related services and Title I services to students attending nonpublic schools located within the district because of parental choice in a manner consistent with the district's overall educational and fiscal responsibilities.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. The school district will make appropriate special education services available to all of its students who are disabled under the IDEA regardless of whether they attend a nonpublic school in the district.
- B. All special education services provided to nonpublic school students will be provided at the public school.
- C. For purposes of this policy, the following definitions shall be used:
 - 1. "Nonpublic school" means any school, church or religious organization, or home school wherein a resident of Minnesota may legally fulfill the compulsory instruction requirements of Minnesota Statute Section 120.101, which is located within the state, and which meets the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. It does not mean a public school.
- D. This policy also applies to the district's provision of Title I services
- E. Requests for evaluation or for special education services to students at nonpublic schools within the district will be reviewed by appropriate district processes. Such requests should be referred to the principals.
