730 Booster Club Interaction

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to identify and describe the relationship between booster clubs and the school district.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The school district has established a relationship with various booster clubs who strive to support, enhance, and complement the district student activities program.

III. DEFINITIONS

- 1. Booster Clubs are non-profit foundations organized by parents and community members to raise funds to benefit student activities.
- 2. Parents and community members are the primary membership. However, there are staff members who may wish to join as well.
- 3. SAA refers to Student Activity Accounts

IV. FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

- 1. Use of the Districts/Schools' name in fund raising activities should be discussed with the superintendent.
- 2. No raffles or games of chance shall take place on school grounds.
- All funds are collected and maintained by the booster club organization.
 The Districts' tax identification number shall not be used. No funds shall be kept in the SAA accounts.

V. PURCHASES FOR SCHOOLS.

- 1. All purchases shall be donated to the school through board approved procedures.
- 2. Staff members should make requests through their principal to the Booster Clubs for the desired donations.
- 3. Donations should be made in cash to allow the purchasing department to buy items that are in line with District purchasing guideline law and liability concerns.
